



# IN-PERSON LEARNING OPEN TO ALL BRONCHOS!

The health and safety of our entire Broncho community has never been more important. Holly Area Schools is committed to offering In-Person Learning for all Bronchos in the 2020-2021 school year, following all state safety requirements and the district's Return to Learn plan.

## PUTTING SAFETY FIRST

### Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)



- Staff must wear facial coverings, except at meals
- Students in grades Y5-12 must wear masks at all times in school, except at meals
- Students and staff must wear masks on the bus

### Continuous cleaning



- Frequently touched surfaces
- Classrooms cleaned after every transition period
- Safe use of cleaning products

### Busing



- Required use of hand sanitizer before boarding bus
- Bus driver, students and staff required to wear facial coverings
- Buses cleaned and disinfected between each route
- Symptomatic students cannot ride the bus

### Promoting good hygiene



- Soap, hand sanitizer, other supplies provided
- Instruction on proper handwashing
- Cooperation with the Oakland County Health Department on all safety protocols

### Spacing and movement throughout the school day

- Y5-5<sup>th</sup>-grade students will remain in one classroom with limited transitions to other areas of the building.
- A majority of 6<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup>-grade students will remain in one classroom with a cohort of peers and have limited transitions to other areas of the building. This will allow teachers to rotate into classrooms and reduce student movement.
