



HOLLY KIWANIS CLUB SCHOLARSHIPS

The Kiwanis Club of Holly is a service organization dedicated to providing a wide range of financial and other types of support and services to the Holly Community. The club awards annual scholarships to students graduating from Holly High School who have distinguished themselves academically and as leaders in extra-curricular activities and services to their communities.

Scholarships consist of cash awards to be used for tuition, room and board, books, equipment or fees for post-high school education or programs. The club reserves the right to alter the scholarship amount depending on the annual scholarship budget.

There are seven scholarships available through the organization.

1. Two athletic scholarships awarded at \$500 each; one for a female scholar athlete and one for a female athlete.
2. Two academic scholarships awarded at \$2000.00 each
3. Two trade scholarships awarded at \$2000.00 each
4. One Edward Thomas Trades Scholarship awarded at \$500.

All applicants must complete ALL items listed on the checklist below:

- Completed application
- High School Transcript
- One Letter of recommendation from an adult within the community (not a family member)
- One letter of recommendation from a teacher

Deadline: The scholarship applications and all supporting documents must be received in the Holly High School Counseling office by March 24, 2026 by 2:30 p.m. Any application that does not include all required documentation will be disqualified.

The Holly Kiwanis Club Trade scholarship is for graduating high school seniors who, as a result of natural ability, hard work, dedication, has been consistently receiving the highest grades in craftsmanship. Students must have consistent attendance with less than six absences for one year in the program. The candidate should also have an overall 3.0 gpa in construction/trade classes and a 3.0 gpa or higher in high school. This scholarship is intended for a student who plans to enter a trade immediately upon completion of high school.
