



Szott Automotive Scholarship

\$1,000 Tool Scholarship

Due March 24, 2026

Purpose

The Szott Automotive Scholarship is designed to support graduating seniors who have demonstrated a strong interest in automotive repair and have shown commitment through their attendance, participation, and professionalism in an Automotive Repair program or demonstrated work history.

Eligibility Requirements

Applicants must meet **all** of the following criteria:

- Be a **current high school senior**
- Be enrolled in and/or actively participating in **Automotive Repair**
- Demonstrate a clear interest in pursuing a career in automotive repair
- Maintain **good attendance**
- Exhibit strong **work ethic and professionalism**

Application Requirements

To be considered, students must submit the following:

1. **Completed Application Form**
2. **Record of Attendance and Participation**
 - Verified enrollment in Automotive Repair or work history from supervisor or program administrator
3. **Student Statement** (see prompt below)

Student Statement

In **300–500 words**, please respond to the following:

- Why are you interested in automotive repair as a career?
- How has your participation in an Automotive Repair program and/or work prepared you for this field?
- How do attendance, work ethic, and professionalism play a role in your future success?
- How will this \$1,000 tool scholarship support your postsecondary or career goals?

Selection Criteria

Applications will be reviewed based on:

- Consistent **attendance and active participation** in an Automotive Repair program
- Demonstrated **interest and commitment** to the automotive field
- Evidence of **professionalism, responsibility, and work ethic**
- Quality and thoughtfulness of the student statement
