By now, you should have received an invitation to our Y5/Kindergarten Jumpstart on Tuesday, August 12<sup>th</sup>, anytime between 4:30 and 6:30 p.m. at Rose Pioneer. The purpose of Jumpstart is to meet our early elementary teachers and have your child engage in brief assessments of their learning and development. Attending this event helps us get to know your child and to establish classroom placements ensuring the best learning environment for our students.

Each year, parents must complete the Skyward Online Verification process. This very important step-by-step online verification process will allow you to receive building communications, verify student emergency contact information, access and review the school handbook, create food service applications, and review other important back to school information. To complete Skyward verification, go to the HAS District web page at <a href="http://www.hask12.org">http://www.hask12.org</a>. Simply click on the "Community/Parents" tab on the screen, and then click the "Skyward Family Access" link to get started. If you do not have your Skyward account login information, you can request it by sending an email to: <a href="maily.access@hask12.org">family.access@hask12.org</a>, or by contacting the office @ 248.328.3800. This process must be completed for <a href="maily.access@hask12.org">each</a> child. Computers will be available at our Open House event for parents who would like assistance.

Our Meet the Teacher Open House is scheduled for Wednesday, August 20th from 5:00 - 6:30 p.m. After completing the Skyward Online Verification process highlighted above, each family will receive their child's classroom teacher placement in Skyward on Tuesday, August 19th. The Open House is an informal drop-in event where parents and children can meet classroom teachers, see the school and have a popsicle on the playground with me. Come anytime between 5:00 and 6:30 that is convenient and we look forward to meeting you!

For the first day of school, Monday, August 25th, we have designed Kindergarten and Young Five parent/child visitation sessions. In order to give everyone ample time we ask that those with the last names that begin with A-M meet from 9:00-10:00. Those with last names beginning with N-Z meet from 10:15-11:15. This is an opportunity for you and your child to formally meet with your teacher, tour the school, and spend an hour getting to know the daily routines and ease those first day jitters. Due to space constraints in classrooms, we ask that only parents accompany their children on this visitation day.


When you arrive with your child for Visitation Day on August 25th, you will park in our front parking lot adjacent to Milford Rd. Please enter through the front main entrance door of the building and sign in. There will be staff members and signs to direct you. We ask that you bring only your Y5/Kindergarten child to the visitation. If you have children in other grades, they will have a normal half day of school from 8:35 am -12:00 pm.
